STIPULATIONS FOR GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. With exception of Common Area III, LINC, student may not use any individual course to fulfill more than 1 area
2. With exception of two courses taken to fulfill Distribution Area IA and IB, a student may use no more than two courses with same course prefix to meet requirements.
3. To fulfill Area IIID on basis of experience, a student must normally 1) receive approval in advance for intent to use to satisfy distribution requirement, 2) participate in an experience of 2 weeks duration or longer, and 3) document the experience through journal and presentation upon return. Note: Restricted to post-high school experiences.
4. Some General Education core requirements may be filled in the major. Consult catalog or academic advisor for specific options.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum 124 semester hours
- Minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in all coursework at Brevard and minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in all courses required for major. Some majors may have more stringent requirements (see major requirements in catalog)
- Complete a minimum of 32 semester hours at Brevard and complete 50% of major requirements at Brevard.
- Errors contained on the checklist do not release the student from meeting graduation requirements as stated in the catalog
